1. NAME:

The name of the Association shall be "Rangitoto College Parent Teacher Association Incorporated".

2. DEFINITION:

Unless the context indicates otherwise, in these rules:

- a) "The College" means Rangitoto College
- b) "Parent" means the mother or father or guardian of a past or present pupil of the College.
- c) "B.O.T" means Board of Trustees.

3. OBJECTIVES:

The objects of the Association shall be:

- a) To promote the welfare of children and young people in general and that of Rangitoto College pupils in particular.
- b) To promote closer understanding and fuller co-operation between home, school and community.
- c) To stimulate interest in education and social problems.
- d) To strive for the best possible education for our children.
- e) To assist with the provision of better amenities for the College.

4. MEMBERSHIP:

Any of the following persons who take an active interest on the affairs of the Association, or who attend the meetings thereof, shall automatically become members of the Association. They shall continue to be members until such time as they resign, cease to take further interest in the Association or to attend meetings thereof:

- a) Any parent or guardian of a past or present pupil.
- b) Any member of the teaching staff of the College.
- c) Any member of the B.O.T.

5. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by an Executive Committee consisting of:

- a) President(s), consisting of either 2 Co-Presidents or 1 President and 1 Vice President, as duly elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- b) The Principal of the College.
- c) Honorary Secretary/Secretaries.
- d) Honorary Treasurer
- e) One person appointed by the B.O.T. as its representative.
- f) One member appointed by the staff of the College.
- g) Six to Ten (6 -10) ordinary members, as duly elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- h) The quorum for any meeting of the Executive Committee shall be 50% personally present.
