#### **Predator control monitoring with Centennial Park Bush Society**

There is an opportunity for two students to serve the Centennial Park Bush Society on the weekend 24 and 25 June. This is a two-day event only taking 2 hours each day located around Campbells Bay. The students need to commit to completing both days. The pest monitoring programme involves placing inked cards which are baited with peanut butter into a tunnel on someone's property. The tunnels are already in place and there is no poison or danger involved. They get put out one day and then brought in the next. This process monitors the volume of foot traffic of pests as well as the types of pests in the area. Completing this service event will count towards the Rangitoto Summit Diploma.
