Years 11-13 remember to complete a Scholarship E-Form under your "Student Information" in PcSchool.

Students interested but not in a timetabled Scholarship class must contact the Teacher in charge of the Subject before signing up by E-Form.

International students – there is a fee (set by NZQA) for each Scholarship entry approved, talk to Mr Hyung Lee before signing up by E-Form.

### **Ready to get your Learners Driver Licence?**
