PPTA Strike Notification - Rolling Strikes


We have been informed from the PPTA this morning of strike action starting later this week. This will involve both rolling strikes and a one day strike.

The Rangitoto College Board and the school have decided to roster home students in the year groups as per the table below. That means that each year group will not be in school for the duration of the 'rostering home' day. It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the days of the rolling strikes. **Rangitoto College will be open for instruction for all other year groups on these days**, with all students, other than those rostered home, expected to attend. There will be no changes to our bus services.

PPTA union members have also voted for one-day regional strikes. The national executive has set the date for this strike in Auckland on 11th May. The Rangitoto College Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff, and unfortunately decided that we cannot provide the normal teaching services for Year 10-13 students during the strike. It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children in Years 10-13 on the day of the strike. **Rangitoto College will be open for instruction for Year 9 students on the 11th May**, with all year 9 students expected to attend. There will be no changes to our bus services.

Strike days:

The strike action will take place on the following days, with the year group identified to stay at home on the dates below. There is also a one day strike that will involve all students except Year 9 (May 11th).
