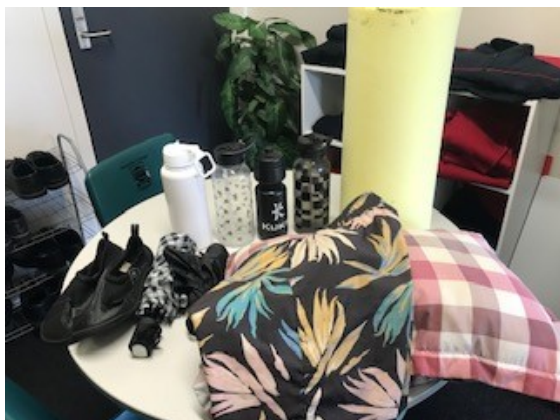

Scaffolding through Sisterhood is back for 2024!

Scaffolding through sisterhood is a work experience programme that runs for 4 - 5 days in this school holidays, focused on increasing Māori and Pacific wahine in the industry.

This group is underrepresented in the industry, and particularly in specialist skilled roles i.e. engineering, surveying, architect and in the trades. The intent of this, is to increase exposure and knowledge of diverse careers and pipeline/pathway into the industry for our wahine.

The roles will be office based but each wahine, will be placed with mentors and teams that will allow students to get a birds eye view of projects and careers across the industry.

Dates – 15th of April Monday to 19th of April Friday. (first week of term one school holiday)

Criteria:

- Female High School student
- Māori or Pacific heritage age (16-18)
- Ability to pass drug/alcohol test
- Be available for the 4 days
- Be able to work approx. between hours. 7.30am – 4.30pm

What the week will look like for our young wahines:

- Big sister/little sister with wahine students being paired with wahine employees across the Link Alliance eco-system
- Connection and mentoring with wider connections in the industry
- Opportunities to experience an authentic workplace
- Exposure to the breadth of careers in the industry

- No cost to school or student
- A graduation/gift presentation to celebrate STS students
- Transport cost to be arranged by student

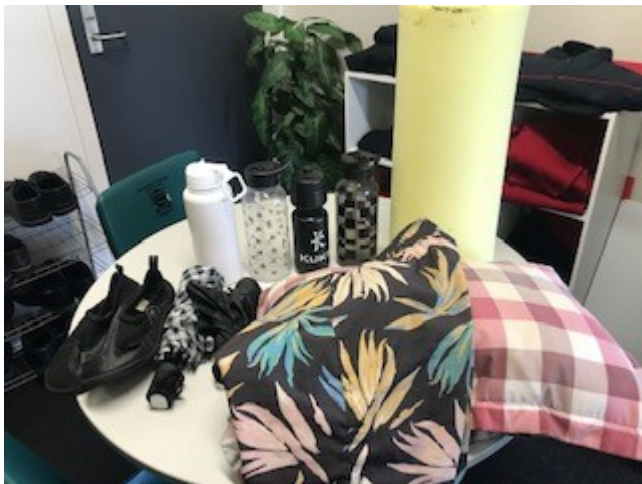
