#### **Principal Update**

The school has been alive with festive activity as term 4 winds up. We were delighted to be invited to join the residents of the Knightsbridge (Aviva) village to acknowledge the strength of the partnership that our communities are forging. Students have been exceptional ambassadors for the College, involving themselves in a range of performances, IT support, oral history collation and environmental causes. We look forward to strengthening our connections in 2025. Thank you to all year 9 and 10 families who contributed to the foodbank collection for Windsor Park distribution. We hope to have provided food packs for over 200 families in need over the Xmas period. Congratulations to the Junior Premier Girls waterpolo team for their exceptional gold medal victory at the North Island championships. Well done to Rose Tindall and Emily Armes for being named MVP and MVP Goalkeeper.

With the school year drawing to a close, this edition of the newsletter looks ahead to 2025, with a range of information relevant to ensuring your child has a smooth start the year included.

## **Literacy and Numeracy results**

You may have seen recent media coverage of the national literacy and numeracy test results last week. We are really pleased with the performance of our students and after testing nearly all of our Year 10 students this year, we have seen increases over the last 12 months in all three of the assessment pass rates; reading up 3% to 84%, writing up 13% to 81% and numeracy up 2% to 86%. National average pass rates for reading (70%) and writing (66%) have seen small improvements, while there has been a significant drop in the national numeracy pass rate, dropping 7%, to 55%. One of our target areas in 2025 is to provide additional support to our ESOL students. To achieve this, we are in the process of developing a range of new courses where literacy and numeracy improvement is the focus.

#### **PCSchool Parent Portal Notification**

To begin 2025, the school will be moving to solely using the PCSchool Parent Portal through PCSchool and no longer have the PCSchool App in operation. The PCSchool App is no longer supported and has poor functionality compared to the PCSchool Parent Portal, hence the reason to remove the App from January 1, 2025.

We would remind parents who have previously used the App for <u>absence notifications</u> to transition to using the Parent Portal. The Parent Portal can be accessed using a mobile phone or appropriate device and the process for absence notification is the same as in the PCSchool App. Indicating the reason in writing for absence is important to ensure we can code this against MOE attendance codes. Some other features in the PCSchool Parent Portal (e.g. attendance records and live reporting) are designed to be viewed on a larger device.

#### Homework

The school has recently refined its guidelines regarding homework, centering around the elements of intentionality, feedback, communication, amount, due date, and personal responsibility. We are adopting a schoolwide approach to use homework to its fullest potential and achieve consistency across the College. Specific information from teachers will be forthcoming at the beginning of next year, including how best to support your child.

#### Year 10 - 13 NCEA Literacy and Numeracy results available

Results from the September literacy and numeracy NCEA testing were recently released. Students can view their results through the PC School (FACTS), student information - results - click on: 'Level 1' section, as well as on their school report and also through their NZQA learner login. Unsuccessful students can access a feedback form via their learner login, which

outlines the specific areas where they did not meet the standard. Students will get another testing opportunity in term one 2025.

#### NCEA Results Release - January 15th

NCEA results will be available on January 15th via <u>student learner logins on the NZQA website</u>. A small number of students may be required to come back to school for one or more days, between January 20 and 27 to sit additional assessments at Level 2 and 3 NCEA to meet NCEA qualification requirements. Parents and students of these students will be contacted in this case.

Scholarship results are released on February 11th.

On February 20th we will be hosting an evening prize giving for all of our successful Scholarship exam recipients as well as our top 25 Year 11 Diploma, NCEA Level 2 and IB 40+ students. Invitations for parents and students will go out early in term one.
