- Diploma offers rigour through a Knowledge rich curriculum
- Academic and social success
- Effectively prepare for Level 2 NCEA or IB

Why not Level 1 NCEA?

New NCEA Levels 2&3 not yet developed
 The Rangitoto Diploma has more academic rigour

*Level 2 - new 2028 *Level 3 - new 2029



What does the Diploma look like?

What do students study?

- Six subjects 14-16 Rangitoto Diploma Credits per subject
- Internal and External assessment fit for purpose
- End of year exams/portfolio submission
