NZI Biology Olympiad 2025/26 – Registration Now Open!

The New Zealand International Biology Olympiad (NZIBO) is back for 2025/26 — and you could be part of it!

NZIBO is an exciting national Biology competition for students who love science and want to stretch their thinking. The entrance exam is a fun but challenging two-hour multiple-choice test designed for NCEA Level 2 Biology students. It includes problem-solving, thinking skills, and real NZ research!

Registration closes: 6 August 2025 (no late entries!)

Online Entrance Exam: 13 August 2025

Any student currently in Year 12 or below can register and sit the entrance exam. If selected, you'll join the NZIBO tutorial programme and could go on to sit the camp selection exam. Only NZ citizens and permanent residents are eligible for the final team selection and training camp — check the full eligibility on the website. \$40 per student

Students who've previously been part of the NZIBO tutorial programme get automatic re-entry — just make sure you register again before the deadline.
