We are pleased to announce that Peace Week is happening again this year at our kura!

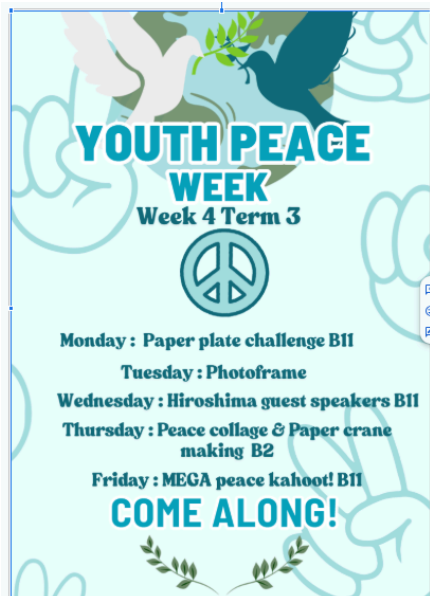
It is a time to reflect on peace and what we can do to bring peace to our every day lives as well as remember victims of conflict from the past and present.
