LOCATION AND FACILITIES

Rangitoto College is located in the North Shore suburb of Mairangi Bay, a 20-minute drive from Auckland City. This residential area combines the most beautiful and safe beaches with regional parks, eateries, shopping centres, sporting venues and more.

For those who prefer to venture out and explore beyond the local community, public transport is easily accessible and full-time high school students are eligible for reduced bus fares.

Our College is like a university campus. It comprises 23 hectares of land, that is the size of over 30 soccer fields together. Students move between purpose-built subject blocks which are well resourced for the wide variety of subjects our school offers.

Our facilities include a library, a health centre, fitness centre, sports fields, tennis and netball courts, a hockey turf, a dance studio, tuck shops and a lot more. Rangitoto College even has its own uniform shop on-site.



ACADEMICS

We recognise each student is unique, and that is why we have created a program that can be personalised to suit students with different abilities and needs. The wide range of subjects to choose from allows students to learn new skills and explore their natural talents, giving them an opportunity to focus on subjects that align with their future aspirations.

International students can study short-term or long-term. Long-term students wanting to graduate from Rangitoto College can choose between NCEA or IB for a pathway to the best universities in the world.

HOMESTAY FAMILIES

Rangitoto College has an international accommodation team dedicated to placing students in homestays. Our host families are carefully selected and home visits are carried out regularly to ensure they continue to provide a safe and supportive environment for our students. Our host families live locally, close to the school, shops and beautiful beaches.

SCHOOL SUPPORT

Our international staff are the main point of contact for international students. We have a dedicated team of both teaching, and non-teaching staff. Our international deans provide academic support and advice, while the non-teaching staff help with accommodation, travel advice and general inquiries. As a team, we all work together to ensure our students are well cared for.

Our in-school nurses and counsellors are also available to support international students.

Students and host families get access to a 24-hour emergency line for urgent after-hours support.

Career advice is available for students in the last 2 years of high school.
