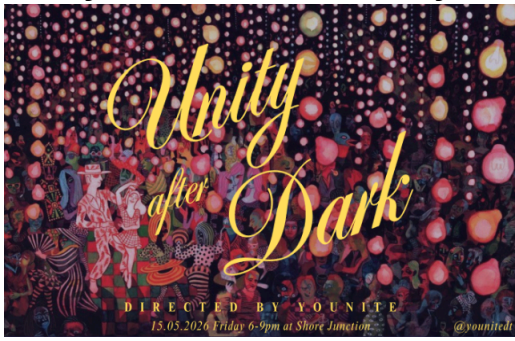

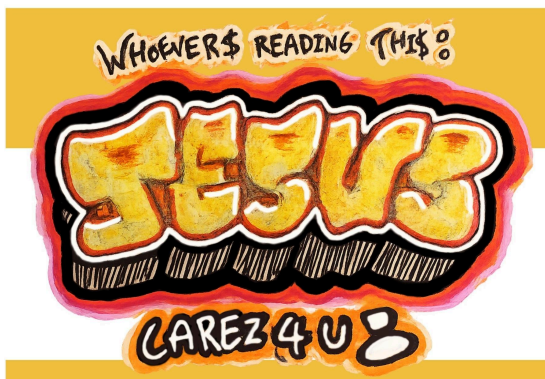

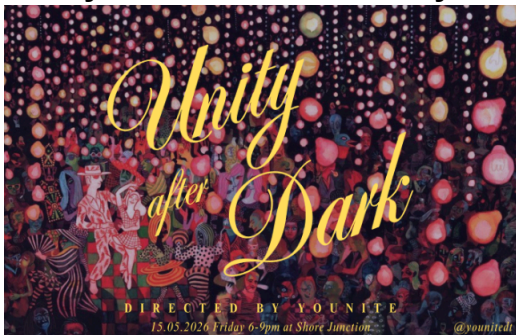
We are so excited to announce the first event of this year, Henna & Harvest, a special lunchtime event celebrating the beautiful fusion of South and Southeast Asian cultures!

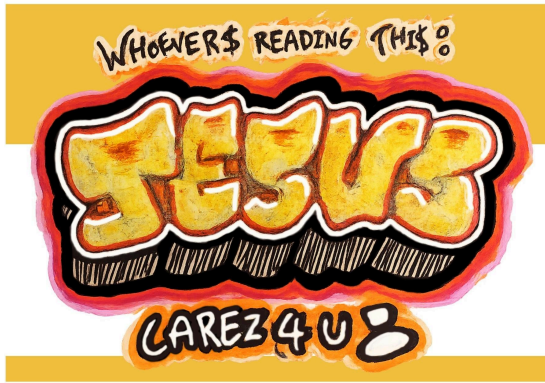
