There will also be opportunities for students to contribute ideas, help shape future sessions, and apply for leadership positions as the club develops.

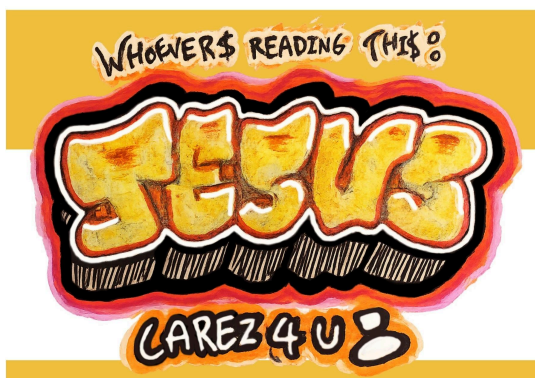
Our first meeting will be on Thursday 11 June in B13. We hope to see you there!

This form is available to the general public as well, so anyone can buy tickets. Tickets are limited so get in before they sell out!

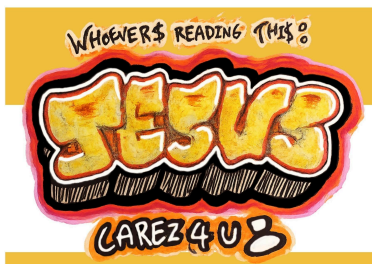
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Rangitoto Medicine Club Quiz! 🩺🏥

This may include having references written, supporting you in completing and submitting applications, providing academic transcripts and other formal documentation, which can only be supplied by Rangitoto College. To access this support, there is a process you MUST follow:

- **Step 1:** Sign-up to attend the Overseas Study Presentation (Link - <https://forms.gle/52y1ucmrSLgbADcJ7>)
- **Step 2:** Attend the Overseas Study Presentation. **Wednesday 10th June, Period 4, in the staffroom.**
- **Step 3 onwards:** Will be shared with you after you attend the presentation.

IMPORTANT: If you do not follow these steps, the school will not be able to support you in any overseas applications or provide any supporting documentation.
