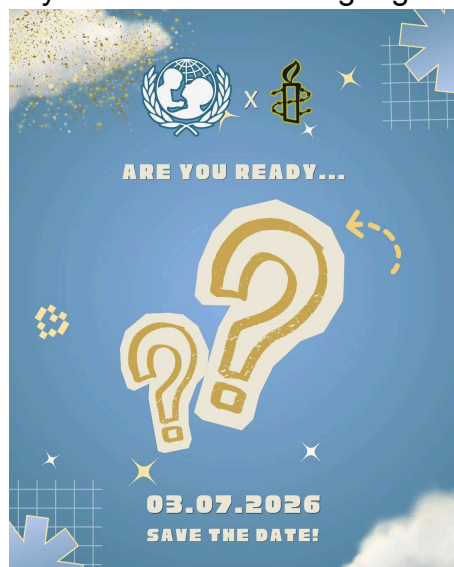

Our Quiz Night will take place on Friday the 3rd of July from 6-9pm (doors open 5:30pm) in the school auditorium!!!

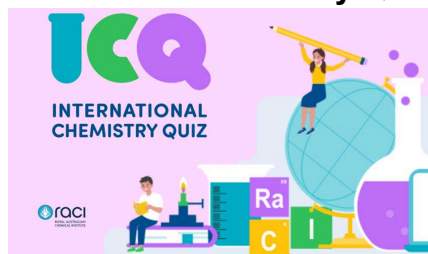

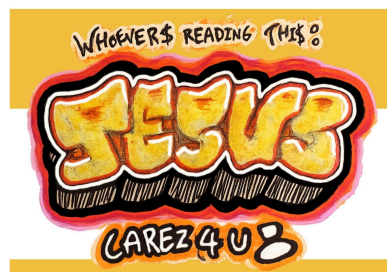

Planning to study Overseas in 2027?

Are you a Year 13 student who is planning to study overseas in 2027? If you are, you will require the support of the Careers Department. This may include having references written, supporting you in completing and submitting applications, providing academic transcripts and other formal documentation, which can only be supplied by Rangitoto College.

To access this support, there is a process you MUST follow:

- **Step 1:** Sign-up to attend the Overseas Study Presentation (Link - <https://forms.gle/52y1ucmrSLgbADcJ7>)
- **Step 2:** Attend the Overseas Study Presentation. **Wednesday 10th June, Period 4, in the staffroom.**
- **Step 3 onwards:** Will be shared with you after you attend the presentation.

IMPORTANT: If you do not follow these steps, the school will not be able to support you in any overseas applications or provide any supporting documentation.

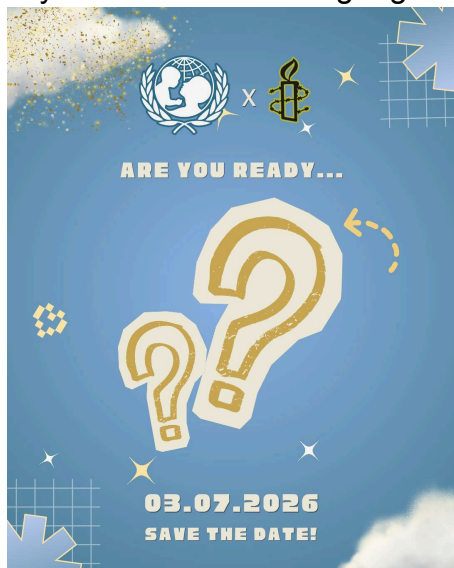

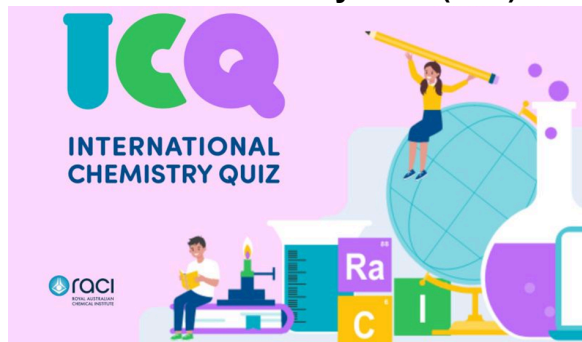

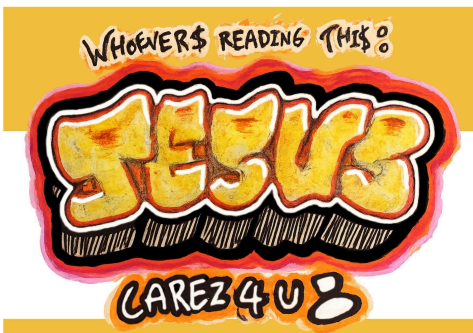
