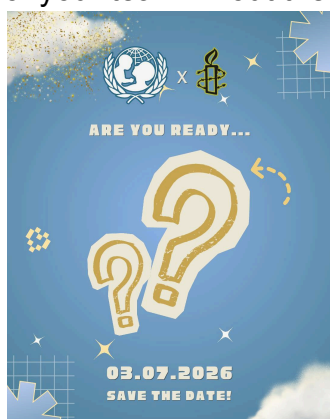
✨HEY EVERYONE!! ✨ We are so excited to announce our **annual quiz night event in collaboration with Amnesty/UNICEF!** 😊

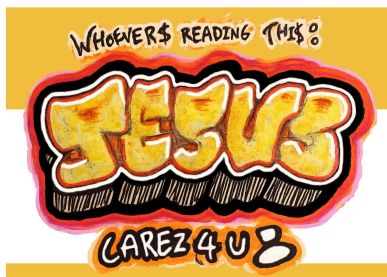

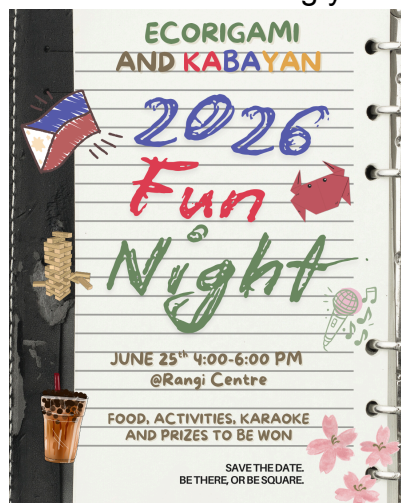
Entry fees are **\$15** and can be paid in front of the auditorium in **Week 9 morning tea and lunchtimes**.

Rangi fun fact of the day: A block and D block are both original buildings that have been here since the school opened.

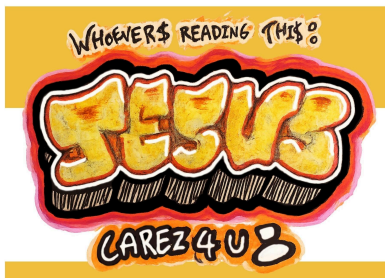
