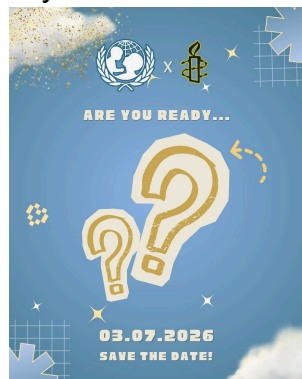
✨ HEY EVERYONE!! ✨ We are so excited to announce our **annual quiz night event in collaboration with Amnesty/UNICEF!** 🤗

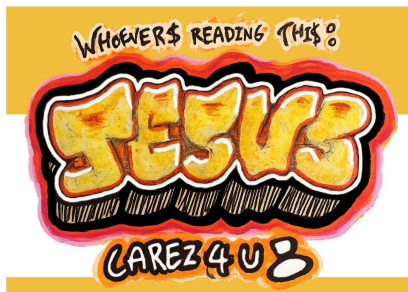

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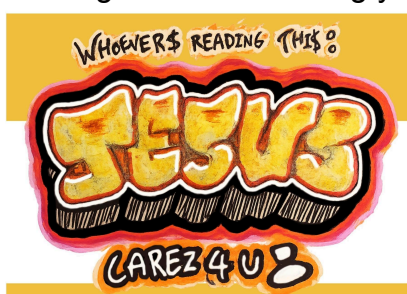
