There will also be opportunities for students to contribute ideas and help shape future sessions as the club continues to grow.

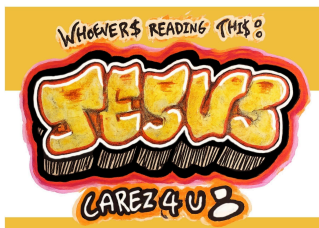

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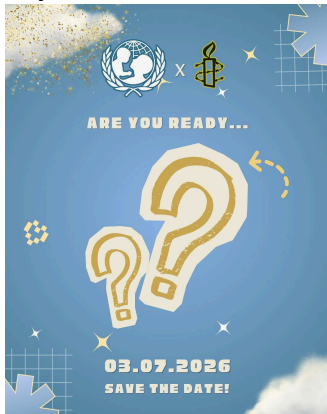
✨ HEY EVERYONE!! ✨ We are so excited to announce our **annual quiz night event in collaboration with Amnesty/UNICEF!** 🤗

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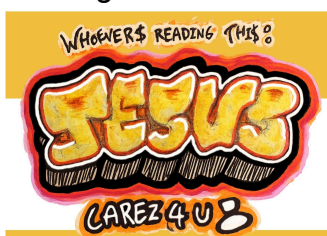
