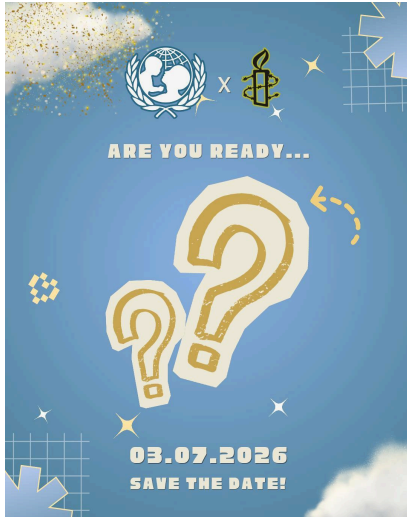

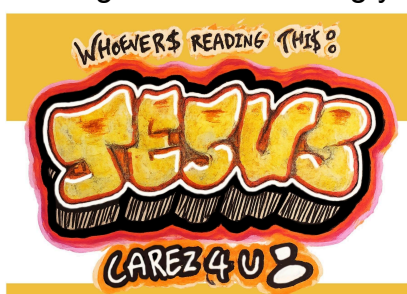

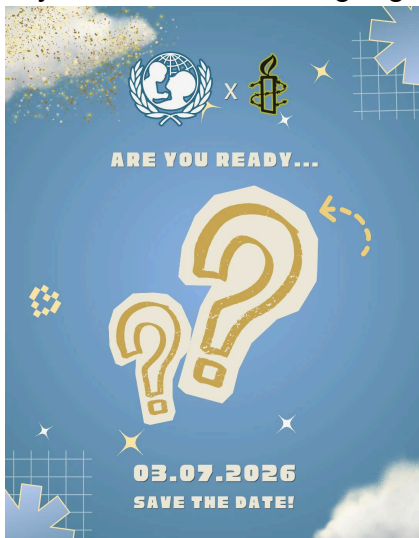

There will also be opportunities for students to contribute ideas and help shape future sessions as the club continues to grow.

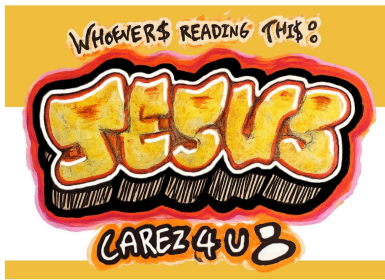
