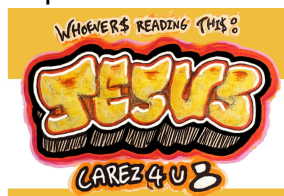

🎨 Rangatahi Art Exhibition – Call for Artists! 🎨

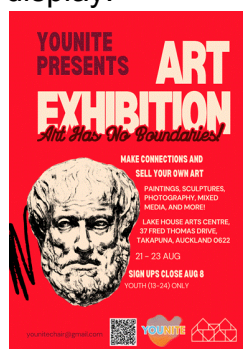
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The exhibition includes a special Open Evening on Friday night (21st) featuring catering, live music, and influential artists who will be available to provide feedback and answer questions about the art industry.

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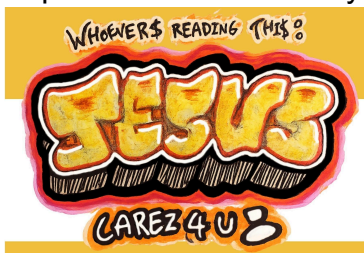

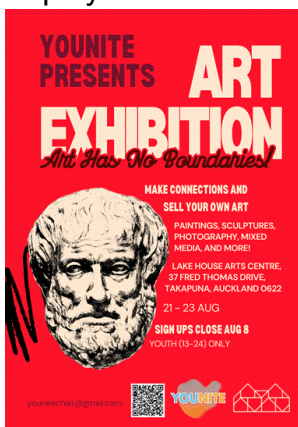
