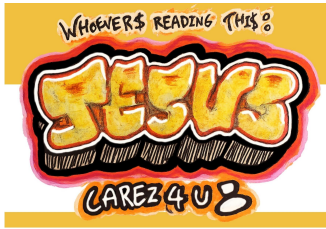

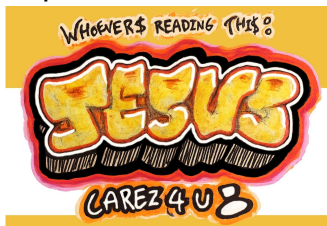

🎨 Rangatahi Art Exhibition – Call for Artists! 🎨

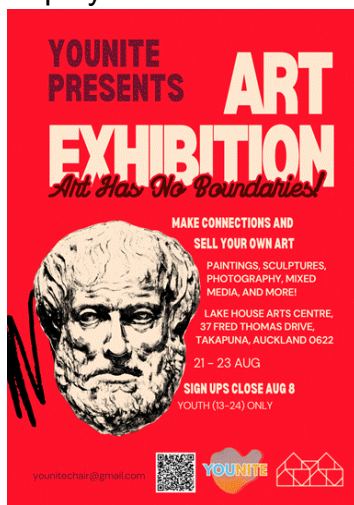
