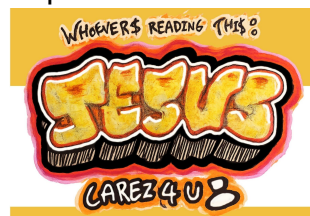

5-Minute Reset: Try a quick, gentle flow to release neck and shoulder tension with this 5-Minute Stretch Routine.

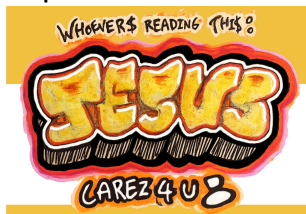
15-Minute Energy Boost: Get your heart rate up and shake off exam stress with this guided 15-Minute Full Body Workout.
