JUNIOR UNIFORM YEARS 9 – 10

JUNIOR – BASIC UNIFORM:

Shorts (Female or Male fit): Plain dark navy dress shorts (no front pleats) with an expandable waist and zip (security) pocket. College logo on the back. To be worn at the waist.

Trousers (Female or Male fit): Rangitoto College long trousers.

Skirt: Knee-length, dark navy poly/wool blend with a centre front pleat and side zip (security) pocket. To be worn at the waist, on the knee.

Blouse or Shirt: Mid-blue polyester, shaped blouse with College logo on the bottom left front hem. To be worn out.

JUNIOR – PE UNIFORM:

All Year 9 & 10 students are required to wear the PE shirt. The shirt is compulsory but can be worn with any plain navy blue or black shorts or leggings.

SENIOR – BASIC UNIFORM:

Shorts (Female or Male fit): Plain dark navy dress shorts (no front pleats) with an expandable waist and zip (security) pocket. College logo on the back. To be worn at the waist.

Trousers (Female or Male fit): Rangitoto College long trousers.

Skirt: Mid-calf, dark navy poly/wool blend straight skirt with two front pleats and side zip (security) pocket. To be worn at the waist, mid-calf length.

YEAR 13 STUDENTS

YEAR 13 STUDENTS:

Smart-casual workplace attire is expected. Avoid beachwear and offensive slogans on t-shirts. To judge acceptable clothing length: with hands by sides, shorts/skirt/dress hemline should be at fingertips or below.

All Year 9-12 Rangitoto College students must wear a school uniform.

You can buy a new uniform from our uniform shop located at school. Otherwise, you can buy a second-hand uniform from our second-hand uniform shop. This is open every Friday during the lunchbreak and is located next to the tennis courts behind E block.

SHOES:

Black Leather Shoes: Plain black, polishable, lace-up shoes. Shoes must be sturdy, support the foot, and have a heel of approximately 1.5-2 cm. Boots, ballet shoes, skate shoes, and sports shoes are not permitted. Shoes are to be worn year-round.

Black Sandals: Sandals with two buckle straps (no heel straps) can be worn with skirts and shorts, but not with long trousers or socks. They can be worn year-round.

BLAZER HIRE

Blazers and Ties are worn at school by the school leaders, premier sports players, top scholarship students and anyone else representing the school.

Blazers can be hired at the School Uniform Shop for \$50 for the calendar year/season. This can be paid directly at the shop or on the parent portal. A Blazer hire agreement will need to be signed by the parent/caregiver, this covers the full replacement cost of the blazer if it isn't returned.

Ties can be purchased at the uniform shop.

Short term hire can also be arranged for one off events for no charge with the permission of a Teacher in Charge or Head of Department.

JEWELLERY

Students can wear up to 2 earrings in each ear, either studs (silver, gold, small stone) or small hoops/sleeper of less than 6mm in diameter and up to 2mm in thickness, without any embellishment such as diamantes or charms that hang off the hoops.

Students may choose to wear the following: one thin, gold or silver short chain necklace with a small pendant; one small silver or gold ring on a finger; one gold or silver bangle or bracelet on the wrist, not ankle. Pandora bracelets are not permitted.

Ear stretchers/spacers of any kind (including clear) are not to be worn.

Jewellery rules apply to all students, including Year 13.

FORMAL UNIFORM

If students are wearing formal uniform (i.e. blazer and tie), with trousers they must wear shoes and socks, not Birkenstocks.

Birkenstocks can be worn with shorts and skirts and should be worn with the ie faitaga.

Both uniform shops are located near the lower courts below the gyms.

Easiest access is via Graham Collins drive, making use of the bottom carpark then walking up the hill.



Blocks

Blocks are labelled using a single letter e.g. A Block, B Block, etc.

Departments

Departments are generally located in the same block.

- A Block - Art, Health, Languages, Māori
- B Block - Social Sciences
- C Block - Commerce
- D Block - Learning Support, Technology
- E Block - English
- G Block - PE
- H Block - Technology
- K Block - Social Science and Health
- M Block - Mathematics
- P Block - Dance, Drama
- S Block – Science

The following are also located in A Block:
