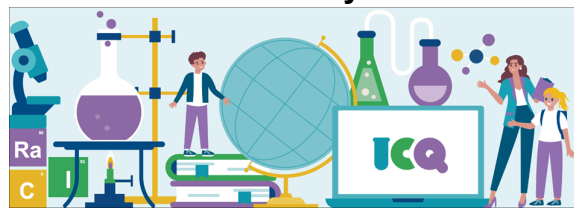

## Interested in Chemistry? Join the ICQ Competition!








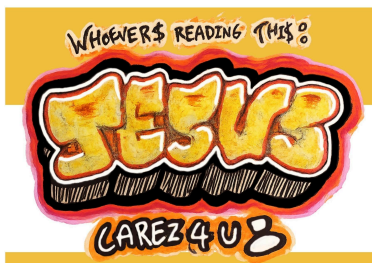
